

ArcGIS 10.6 Prerelease Release Notes

Known limitations and issues

Licensing

- License Server Administrator and Software Authorization Wizard do not display version 2.1 for the forthcoming release of ArcGIS Pro. Software functions normally.
- License Server Administrator installed Reference Guide does not display version 10.6 for the latest release. Please read version 10.5.1 for any version 10.6 help references. Software functions the same as version 10.5.1. This will be updated for Final release.

ArcGIS Enterprise

Portal for ArcGIS

Upgrades

- Upgrading to Prerelease from earlier versions is not supported.
- Upgrading from Prerelease to any future version is not supported.

Administration

- ArcGIS Web Adaptor (IIS) configuration page is not properly localized for the chosen locale.
- Unable to restore an incremental backup for Portal for ArcGIS.
- In a highly available portal configuration, the index on the secondary portal is not updated after a failover.

Portal Home Application

- Publishing large hosted feature services with sync enabled to Portal is slow and periodically fails.
- Feature layers shared to a collaboration may not exceed 50 MB when replicated.

Living Atlas

- Searching from the Group tab erroneously returns the two Living Atlas groups (Living Atlas and Living Atlas Analysis Layers). Workaround: Ignore these groups and as their properties should not be edited.

Scene Viewer

- Sign in and sign out within the Scene Viewer are not working properly. Workaround: Sign in and out through the portal.
- Local scenes authoring in the Scene Viewer is limited to layers and basemaps with the same projection (drop basemap workflow is not correctly working).

GeoPlanner

- Unable to log into GeoPlanner using PKI.
- For Analysis, Dissolve Boundaries fails when using design layer.
- GeoPlanner for Portal 10.6 doesn't load when using HTTP. Workaround: GeoPlanner works as expected when accessed via HTTPS.
- Extrusion and color change not working in 3D Settings

ArcGIS Server

Upgrades

- Upgrading to Prerelease from earlier versions is not supported.
- Upgrading from Prerelease to any future version is not supported.

Administration

- ArcGIS Web Adaptor (IIS) configuration page is not properly localized for the chosen locale.

Spatial Analysis

Custom Web Tools

- Working with and consuming custom web tools in the Portal for ArcGIS web map viewer is still under development for 10.6 Prerelease.

ArcGIS 10.6 Prerelease Release Notes

- Results generated from custom web tools can be drawn on the web map but a result layer will not be created. These results cannot be used as input to other analysis tools and they cannot be saved as items.
- Web tools cannot be saved or persisted in the analysis menu. For the final release of 10.6, we will be implementing functionality for browsing to your web tool items directly from the analysis menu.
